The responsibility for determining whether a college course satisfies a high school graduation requirement rests with the student's school district. Students should consult with their school counselor before finalizing their college course schedule.

Not all courses listed are guaranteed to be offered on all of Ohio University's campus or available online every semester. Please plan ahead by working with your academic advisor to create a schedule based on available course offerings.

Admission to CC+ does not guarantee availability of or admission to specific courses. In accordance with the Ohio Revised Code, Ohio University must take care to give registration priority to its degree-seeking students while attempting to provide CC+ students with reasonable class choices. Therefore, it is strongly recommended that students fulfill graduation requirements at their high school. However, once a CC+ student has officially registered for a course they will not be displaced.

Participants in the CC+ program are encouraged to work closely with their college advisor and high school counselors to assure that they are taking the proper courses, including those necessary for high school graduation credit.
