WHAT IS PROGRAM EVALUATION?

Program Evaluation is a systematic process to determine or judge:

Merit

- Intrinsic value of program
- "Quality"
- Effectiveness of design

Worth

 Likelihood of the program achieving the relevant goals

Value

 Efficacy of the program relative to other approaches

Significance

 Impact of the program

Program Evaluation

- Purpose is to determine the effectiveness of a specific program, product, policy, or model.
- Questions originate with key stakeholders and primary intended users of evaluation findings.
- Quality and importance is judged by those who will use findings to take action and make decisions.
- Ultimate test of value is usefulness to improve effectiveness
- Draws evaluative conclusions about quality, merit, and worth.
