

## **Regional Higher Education Petition for Reinstatement**

Prior to submitting a Petition for Reinstatement, you must meet with your Ohio University probation advisor to review your plan of action, discuss available campus resources, and review your academic record.

## Guidelines for Submitting this Petition:

- 1. Submitting a petition does not guarantee reinstatement.
- 2. This petition must be submitted at least four weeks prior to the semester in which you wish to return. NOTE: reinstatement will not be granted until at least 12 months after your dismissal.
- 3. Petitions must be submitted along with a Probation Advisor Review Form. Petitions submitted without this form will not be considered.
- 4. If you have attended another college during the dismissal period, you MUST supply an OFFICIAL transcript in conjunction with this petition in order for it to be reviewed.
- 5. The Petition for Reinstatement should be completed legibly, honestly, and carefully. Petitions may not be submitted in pencil.
- 6. When possible, your petition should be submitted with documentation to support your responses.
