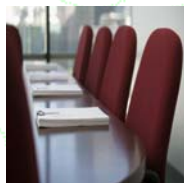


"Two Snakes, Two Teeth" Sergey Kahn, Morocco

Attention Student Organizations:



Beginning in Spring Quarter, Baker University Center will implement a cancellation fee for room reservations in Baker that are not used and that are not cancelled at least 3 business days in advance (10 business days in advance for a Ballroom event). This fee will apply to all University departments and student organizations. The cancellation fee will be 50% of whatever an external group would be charged as a room rental fee. As an example, failure to cancel the Multipurpose Room (240/242) would result in a charge of \$150 and failure to cancel a Ballroom event would result in a charge of \$400. Please make sure that you and all members of your student organization get in the habit of canceling space you won't be using in Baker at least 3 business days in advance (10 business days for a Ballroom event) if not more. This will ensure you don't get billed and it will allow other users the opportunity to use the space.

Student Organization Mailboxes:



Don't forget to check your student organization mailbox regularly! All student organizations have a mailbox assigned to them, and it is located in the hallway on the 3rd floor of Baker University Center between the Greek Governing Suite and the Amanda J. Cunningham Leadership Center. You should check this on a regular basis because important information from other student organizations and the Department of Campus Life, as well as your mail, is delivered to this mailbox.
