

**Sue and Charles Glander Study Abroad Scholarship  
for Romance Languages**

**Eligibility Criteria:**

- Full-time, degree-seeking undergraduate students enrolled in or accepted for admission to Ohio University.
- U.S. citizens or permanent residents.
- A cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 at Ohio University.
- Must be studying one of the Romance languages taught in the Department of Modern Languages at O.U.: French, Italian, Portuguese or Spanish.

**Selection Procedure and Criteria:**

- The recipients will be selected by the Scholarship Committee in the Department of Modern Languages.
- Recipients will be chosen principally on the basis of academic performance or potential.
- Financial need will be a consideration, as determined by the O.U. Financial Aid Office. A FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is required. Check with the Financial Aid office for details.
- First preference will be given to non-traditional students majoring in French and coming from a branch campus.
- If the previous preference cannot be met, the award can be granted to any Romance language major for a study abroad program.
