COURSES CAN NEVER BE COUNTED TWICE TOWARDS GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS, EVEN IF DARS SAYS SO

Exceptions: Math Minors or Other minors, where courses count toward a different degree major.

- For those who advise EE and/or CpE students, please remind your students about the following:
 - **EE students take EE 395B prior to EE 334 (which is now offered F, Sp).**
 - DARS reports are only advising documents, and do not guarantee graduation
 - EE 221 must be taken with EE 211 and prior to EE 212.
 - Math 440-EE 321-EE 395C sequence cannot be broken.
 - Math 440 is offered Fall and Winter only.
 - EE 321 is offered Winter and Spring only; EE 395C is offered Fall and Spring only
 - Co-op students can take EE 395C along with EE 495A as long as the 44 credit hour requirement in EE is satisfied
 - Understand the Breadth and Depth requirement in general education courses which in general described with either the 2+2 or the 3+1 model. Pick up the relative handout from Stocker 359. **For students entering 2008/09 academic year, or later, this no longer applies.**

- For those who advise Computer Engineers, please remind your students that EE 461A is now a 4 credit hour mandatory course and is offered every fall quarter only. Also EE 371 must be taken prior to EE 352.
- CS 456 is no longer required for CpE majors. Instead, students must take an extra Senior Elective from the CpE group: EE 467, 468, 462, 415, 416, CS 475, 425, 442, 444, 458 (others by approval)
- ENG 305J is no longer offered.
 - CS students should take Eng. 306J or 308J or 309J, but could take any J course.
 - EE – students can take any J course

- Remind CS and CpE Students of the offering schedule for CS courses:
 - CS 240A -- Fall, Winter, (Summer with sufficient demand)
 - CS 240B -- Winter, Spring
 - CS 265A -- Winter, Spring
 - CS 240C -- Fall, Spring
 - CS 300 -- Fall, Winter
 - CS 320 -- Winter, Spring
 - CS 361 -- Fall, Spring
