It begins by probing key terms such as “Sufism,” “asceticism,” and “mysticism.” It then traces the emergence of Sufism during the formative period of the Islamic political and religious systems. The bulk of the course explores contemporary manifestations of Sufism in Indonesia, Morocco, Turkey, and the US/UK. Effective: S 08/09

Students will read original sources and historical scholarship on a particular period or theme in history. Each week individuals will help lead discussion of the assigned readings, so that all students will encounter the challenges and rewards of scholarly exchange.
