CHAIRS REPORT: David Thomas

Thomas called the meeting to order at 3:00p.m.

Thomas thanked everyone for attending the special meeting of the University Curriculum Council.

Thomas reminded everyone that the purpose of this meeting was to address the issue of major codes that are on the books that have been identified by Colleges for phase out or inactivation. He outlined the steps that had been taken to date. The list brought for second reading has been clarified. The registrar asked that three Non Degree codes for exchange students remain on the books.

Benton clarified that there are multiple meanings for ND codes. A student will never graduate from an ND code. There are ND codes that are degree seeking. The student hasn't declared what program they've decided to graduate from. These are holding codes. Tadlock explained that graduate students will never graduate under an ND code.

Thomas informed the Council that the College of Business would like to have their codes which were left out of the first list reviewed as well.
