Thomas welcomed special guests President Roderick McDavis, Don Pendergast, Project Director for the Digitalization of UCC and Alan Chen from the Office of Information Technology.

Pendergast gave a demo presentation of the OCEAN (Ohio Curriculum Enhancement And Approval Network) System—the digitization project begun last summer. Pendergast said that the demo was still in the conception phase. Questions followed and the overall reaction was very positive. Thomas asked that any suggestions or questions be forwarded to him.

President McDavis thanked Thomas for his leadership and he thanked Pendergast and the “gang” for moving this project forward. He feels it will be a major step in saving time and energy in the major conversion from quarters to semester. Thomas thanked President McDavis for attending.
