CHAIRS REPORT: David Thomas

Thomas called the meeting to order at 3:15p.m.

Thomas welcomed everyone to the eighth meeting of the University Curriculum Council.

Thomas asked for a motion to accept the April 14, 2009 minutes. Brown moved and Quitslund seconded. Minutes unanimously approved by voice vote.

Thomas informed the Council that he had been re-elected to the Vice Chair of Faculty Senate And thus will be chairing the University Curriculum Council for the coming year.

Thomas informed the Council that the digitization process is moving along well and should go live with the NOI on May 18. Thomas thanked the “Gang” for their hard work.

Thomas informed the Council that he will appoint the Friday group to continue to meet to handle any issues or appeals that might come up with the Q2S transition.

Thomas introduced Giesey who presented the Q2S Guidelines, submitted by the “Friday Group” and by the Q2S Task Force for vote. One contradiction was pointed out on Page 5 between bullet 2 (We will follow normal UCC process for both programs and courses) and bullet 7 (The UCC process utilized for the transition review will not be implemented in its current formation). Bullet 2 will be changed to clarify the change in the normal process. “Decision-making process will be added to bullet 2. The Guidelines were approved by voice vote with 2 abstentions.

Thomas and the Council thanked Jeff Giesey for all his hard work with the Guidelines and the Q2S team.

PROGRAMS COMMITTEE: Tracy Leinbaugh, Chair

Leinbaugh informed the Council that the signature sheet from the College of Health and Human Services was received.

 - b. Prepare students work within the equine industry
 - c. Approved by voice vote

REVIEW COMMITTEE: Jeff Connor, Chair

No reviews were presented.

Connor informed the Council that the committee recommends that program reviews be on a possible hiatus for 2009-2010 due to Q2S. The committee will catch up with current reviews and will try to streamline the process. Concerns were raised that the Doctoral programs are required by Ohio Board of Regents reviewed every eight years. It was decided that if a program wishes to be reviewed they can request it.

Motion was made to have a hiatus on seven year review next year for all programs possible and setting the program review clock back one year for all other programs. Motion approved by voice vote.
