Re: Relocation of Language courses (Revision from April, 2010)



Keeping this organizational scheme would only continue to cause confusion into the future. For that reason, we are revising our relocation proposal so that they are all placed in the INTS "department" existing in OCEAN within the College of Arts and Sciences.



This program relocation will benefit undergraduate and graduate education by ensuring that all OHIO students have continued access to a diversity of language coursework funded through National Resource Centers within the Center for International Studies. Keeping the languages within the College of Arts and Sciences and continuing to align them pedagogically and administratively (same numbering and credit system) with other languages and will allow all undergraduate Arts and Sciences students to enroll in them for College Foreign Language and/or Humanities credit.

The Southeast Asian and African Language Coordinators and Teaching Assistants are currently and will continue to be paid through National Resource Center grants through the Center for International Studies. The African Language Coordinator is a Linguistics faculty member. The process leading to the development of this proposal entailed ongoing discussion for the past year between Chris Thompson, Chair of the Department of Linguistics in the College of Arts and Sciences, Tom Scanlan, Associate Dean for Student and Curricular Affairs of College of Arts and Sciences, and Dan Weiner, Executive Director of the Center for International Studies.
