CTBINU - BIOINFORMATICS CERTIFICATE	24 (20%)	Since the undergraduate bioinformatics certificate was just approved, the curriculum described above is mostly a one-to-one translation from the quarter curriculum to the semester curriculum. The substantive changes are (i) ChE 408 is not going to be taught in that form under semesters, and so it is not included as a possible statistics course, (ii) the Cell Biology section under quarters was replaced by the "additional biology" section that allows students to take an additional biology course instead of a specific course in cell biology, and (iii) a new course (PBIO 4280) was added as an option under the Laboratory Practicum section.

There does not seem to be a limit under semesters so we'd like to make them 3 semester-hour classes. 1. The increase in credit hours enable the classes to cover the topics in greater depth. 2. The students and the faculty who teach the courses requested the change. 3. There is no potential to harm any programs.	None

The 16 hour load was within the guidelines established by the University Curriculum Council. The semester version is the same thing but, because the minimum is now 14 hours, we have added an elective course.</p> <p>Clarification: Clarify language under elective. Does it need to be approved, and by whom?</p>	None
MA4211 - HISTORY		This program WILL NOT be offered in semesters. Comments: It is an obsolete code. All History MAs are 4215	
MA4215 - HISTORY	32 (-4%)	<p>The thesis option required ten courses under the quarter system and will require seven courses under the semester system. The change conforms to the conversion ratio of 3:2. The same is true of non-thesis option, which required twelve courses under the quarter system and will require eight courses under the semester system.</p> <p>Explanation required: Show the thesis and its hours as a curricular component along with the thesis option so that the hours add up properly. It seems like the thesis will only count for 4 hours. If so, why is it so low?</p>	
PH4215 - HISTORY	90 (29%)	<p>Program changes from 21 quarter courses to 14 semester courses, conforming to the conversion ratio of 3:2. Completion of required courses required seven quarters and will require seven semesters.</p> <p>Clarification required: Summary statement implies an extra year to complete coursework. Is that a true statement? Also, the '34 credits for mass transfer' seems too high since the minimum hours for an MS are 32.</p> <p>Typo – there is a 'for' missing in the line starting "Students who transfer from another Ph.D. program..."</p>
