

Pickerington MFE Program

1. The MFE program provides graduate study in Economics, Accounting and Finance. The program is unique in that it allows students to study these three disciplines, not just one discipline. Faculty from the College of Arts & Sciences and the College of Business provide instruction.
2. Many students in the Pickerington program are employed in the financial industry. Thus the program is of keen interest to them because it offers them an opportunity to advance in their careers.
3. Enrollment goal for cohort beginning in January 2009 was 25 students. Goal was met.
4. Enrollment goal for cohort beginning in January 2010 is 25 students. The program will strive to meet that goal, though the economy is a concern.
