

Charge to the Graduate Education and Research Board

Membership of the Graduate Education and Research Board will consist of the Vice President for Research, the Associate Provost for Graduate Studies, four deans, and faculty representatives from Graduate Council and the council for Research Scholarship and Creative Activity (CRSCA). Three at-large faculty members will also be appointed. The term of this appointment is two years. All colleges must have at least one dean or faculty representative on the board.

This board will play a critical role in achieving the goals described in Vision OHIO. Its primary purpose is to develop a process that will prioritize specific research/creativity and graduate education initiatives to recommend to the President and Provost for strategic investment of central funds consistent with the discussion of Graduate Education and Research Priorities in Vision Ohio.

The specific charge to the board is as follows:

- 1) Develop a Request for Proposals in response to the priorities identified in the Vision OHIO Graduate Priorities statement.
- 2) Recommend graduate education and research/creative activity investments based on proposals submitted.
- 3) Recommend a graduate review process to assess program quality according to the goals of Vision OHIO.
- 4) Develop an ongoing process for assessing opportunities and identifying new directions in graduate education and research/creative activity priorities.
