ADMISSION TO INDUSTRIAL TECHNOLOGY

Students may request admission into the Industrial Technology program through one of three alternatives. All who apply for admission into the program must comply with the following procedures, as appropriate.

FIRST QUARTER FRESHMAN STUDENTS

Students accepted at OU as entering freshmen can request direct entry in the Industrial Technology program. There are no additional requirements beyond the general requirements for admission to Ohio University.

STUDENTS TRANSFERRING FROM ANOTHER INSTITUTION

Transfer students from other accredited universities or colleges may directly enter the Industrial Technology program providing they meet all minimum OU admissions requirements.

STUDENTS TRANSFERRING FROM WITHIN OHIO UNIVERSITY

Students who wish to transfer into Industrial Technology from another department in the Russ College of Engineering and Technology or another college at Ohio University must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 all university courses. Additional criteria for the college include a 2.0 Engineering GPA, a 2.0 Industrial Technology GPA and successful completion of any required course by the third enrollment. Students who are on academic probation will not be admitted to the program.

It is recommend that prospective Industrial Technology students meet with the department chairman for a general counseling session to assure that the student understands the nature and scope of the program.

Procedure

1. Student will complete an official *Application for Update of Program* form; available from the Office of Student Records; 159 Stocker Center.
2. The Associate Dean for Academics will review the application to ensure compliance with college and department entry criteria.
3. Student will meet with the departmental chairman prior to their second quarter of enrollment. The purpose of the meeting is to:
 - assess past coursework as applied to the BSIT degree requirements,
 - setup the departmental advising record for the student
 - assign a regular departmental advisor
 - and provide general counseling

After transferring into the Industrial Technology program, a student must earn a minimum of 36 quarter hours of Industrial Technology (IT) credit at Ohio University with at least 24 credit hours at or above the 300 level.
