

OPI test results

1. After you have completed your telephone interview, the tester will make an evaluation of your exam then send the recording to a second evaluator.
2. It may take two weeks for results to come in (not counting the weekend). Sometimes results come in quicker; sometimes they take longer. Please be patient.
3. You should keep the initial e-mail confirmation from LTI as it tells you the date and time of your interview AND has a link and log in that allows you to retrieve your results from the LTI/ACTFL website.
4. Dr. Partyka will also have access to your results; however, she will not e-mail those results to you unless you request them. Please note, you will not receive results by e-mail.
5. All passing results are then sent to the appropriate person in your college who is asked to mark your DARS accordingly. If it does not show up on your DARS, please e-mail Dr. Partyka and she will resend the results (partyka@ohio.edu).
6. If you want the certificate, you should be able to download that from the site where you access your results. You should request the *official certificate* at the time of registration.
