## Bobcat Student Orientation 2009

### Purpose

Bobcat Student Orientation enables new Ohio University transfer students and their parents or spouse to meet with faculty, staff, and student advisors to prepare for fall quarter. Orientation is required of all new Athens campus students. You must arrange to attend the entire program. Parents and spouses are also invited to attend Orientation and participate in a separate orientation program while students are participating in the student program. Parents and spouses do not need to make reservations to attend Orientation. During Orientation, you will:

- learn about the curriculum;
- take placement tests (Chemistry or foreign language if necessary);
- register for fall quarter classes;
- meet other students in your college;
- have your student identification card picture taken (bring photo i.d.);
- learn of the wide variety of on-campus social activities;
- tour the campus with a student orientation leader.

### Preparing for Bobcat Student Orientation

**ORIENTATION FEES:** For students, the Orientation cost is \$50, which includes the program fee, all materials, and lunch. For parents, the fee is \$20 for each person, which covers the program, all materials, and lunch. Orientation fees will be assessed when you arrive. These fees will be billed to your student account. Please do not send payment in advance.

**ORIENTATION HOUSING:** If you arrive the evening before your program begins, rooms are available from 6:00 p.m. for \$29 per person per night. Housing staff are available throughout the night for check-in. Advance reservations are necessary for early arrivals. Information about the Orientation residence hall will be in the materials you receive once you register on-line for the program.

Towels, sheets, and pillows are provided. The Orientation residence hall is air-conditioned. If you have a mobility limitation and need special housing accommodations, contact Conference Services at 740.566.9700 as soon as possible.
