

## Bobcat Student Orientation -- March 16, 2012

*We are glad you are coming to Ohio University - Athens to learn more about being a student and community member here! At Bobcat Student Orientation you will receive information about the resources available to you on campus and advice about your major. You will also register for spring quarter classes. To register to attend Orientation, please log on to <https://my.ohio.edu> and look for information about Bobcat Student Orientation. All registration, including payment of \$35.00, is done on-line. Here are some important things you need to know to make your orientation process go smoothly:*

- When you come to campus, you will be able to get a University ID, so you need to **bring a Driver's License** or state ID.
- Course registration will be done on-line. If you have a **laptop computer**, it would be helpful for you to bring that. We will also provide computer resources if you are not able to bring a laptop.
- **Math placement** is based on your ACT or SAT score if you are a first year student. If you are a transfer student and took a math course at a different institution, your math placement will be based on the level of that course. Please read the information on the orientation web page to learn about the courses available for each level and how to improve your level.
- If you read about the major you are interested in before you come to campus that will help with the advising process. You can **read about your** major at [www.ohio.edu/catalogs](http://www.ohio.edu/catalogs)
- If you are bringing **transfer credits** with you from another institution, please request that an official transcript be mailed to Ohio University, Office of Admissions, 120 Chubb Hall. Please also bring a copy of any transcripts from other schools with you. Sometimes they are helpful during the advising process.
- Billing information is available through <https://my.ohio.edu>. Look for the "Accounts" tab, and follow the link to "MyOhio Student Center". Under the finance section there is a link that says "Account Inquiry". Check the "Charges Due" tab to see what is due when. As soon as possible, add authorized users so anyone helping you pay the bills gets the notices as well.
