WANTED FOR ATTEMPTED BURGLARY

CASE NUMBER: 09-0083269 (APD)

DATE/TIME OCCURRED: Monday, September 22, 2009, at approximately 2:00 a.m.

LOCATION: 121½ East State Street

SUSPECT DESCRIPTION: Two white males, one tall and thin, one shorter

NARRATIVE:

At approximately 10:00 a.m. on Monday, September 22, 2009, a male student reported to Athens City police that at approximately 2:00 a.m. that morning, the two suspects described above attempted to force entry into his apartment at 121½ East State Street. The victim reported to police that he was awakened by someone pounding on his door; when he answered, the suspects attempted to force their way inside. One of the suspects was carrying what appeared to be a gun. An altercation took place and the victim succeeded in pushing the suspects out of his apartment. The victim reported the suspects' faces were obscured and the hallway was dark, so he was unable to provide a more detailed description. The victim reported he suffered minor injuries during the incident, which is under investigation.
