Message from the President

hio University was founded during a time in our nation's history when the stroke of a pen could start a revolution, form a new government, and claim ownership for land beyond our borders. On February 18, 1804, it was a pen that declared Ohio University the first university in the new state of Ohio, an innovative idea during a time when public education was not yet accepted as a universal right for all citizens. At the moment of Ohio University's founding, we existed simply on paper and in the hearts and minds of Revolutionary War veterans Manasseh Cutler and Rufus Putnam, who fought for our nation's independence.
