Resolution for Updating Language Concerning Graduate Council Membership

Resolution of Handbook Policy EPSA [Draft 9-27-23] Ohio University

Whereas the Graduate Council is a body established by the Faculty Senate to review, coordinate, and advocate for graduate education at Ohio University.

Whereas Section VII.c of the faculty handbook defines the structure of Graduate Council and specifies that the roster of administrators should include

the deans or designees of the following Colleges: Arts and Sciences, Business, Scripps, Patton, Russ, Fine Arts, Health Sciences and Professions, Heritage College of Osteopathic Medicine and Universities Libraries; and the directors or designees of the Center for International Studies and the Voinovich School;

Whereas the Voinovich School is led by a dean.

Whereas University Libraries is led by a dean but is neither a college nor a school.

Whereas the Center for International Studies is not led by a dean (or equivalent) after a recent reorganization as a center within the College of Arts and Sciences.

Therefore, be it resolved, that the above handbook language be amended as follows:

the deans or designees of the following Colleges or Schools: Arts and Sciences, Business, Scripps, Patton, Russ, Fine Arts, Voinovich, Health Sciences and Professions, Heritage College of Osteopathic Medicine and Universities Libraries; as well as the dean of University Libraries or their designee. and the director or designees of the Center for International Studies and the Voinovich School;
