OVERVIEW:

The George Washington Forum will award up to five (5) undergraduate research fellowships for the 2013–2014 academic year. The award winners will be mentored by select Washington Forum affiliate faculty members and will provide those faculty members with 5 hours of research assistance per week. The fellowships are each worth \$3,500 and are open to students in all majors and colleges.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES:

- Applicants must be undergraduates at Ohio University.
- Applicants may be enrolled in any college within Ohio University.
- Applicants must have a 3.5 GPA.

- 2. Undergraduate transcript
- 3. Résumé
- 4. Statement (1 page) of how the undergraduate research fellowship will benefit you.
- 5. Brief essay (2-3 pages) responding to the following excerpt from F.A. Hayek's Individualism and Economic Order (1948): 'There is all the difference in the world between treating people equally and attempting to make them equal. While the first is the condition of a free society, the second means, as De Tocqueville described it, "a new form of servitude."
