

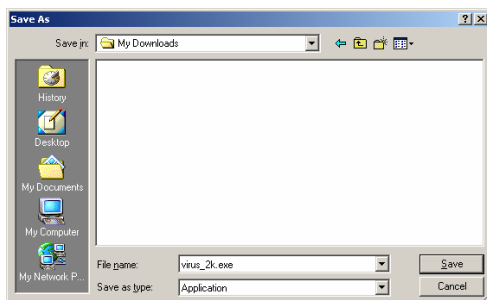
## Download from CNS Web site

1. Visit [www.cns.ohiou.edu](http://www.cns.ohiou.edu) (Note: Always Uninstall older versions.)
2. Click **Downloads** on the tool bar across the top of the page.
3. Click on **McAfee Anti-Virus - for Windows** Link.
4. Now click **Download: McAfee**.

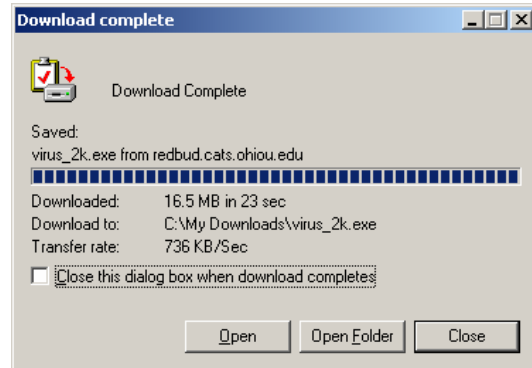


You must enter a valid OAK username and Password to download the installation program. Your OAK password will need to have been changed in the last two years.

5. You will be taken to the Software Distribution page and Authenticated as user "OAK USER". From here you need to select McAfee/Virex 4.5.1 and choose the correct version from the list: Windows 2000, 98, or NT. Once you have the correct version selected click the **Download** button.
6. Choose where to save the install file to on your hard drive and click the **Save** button. (Save to the *Desktop* for an easy place to find your file.)

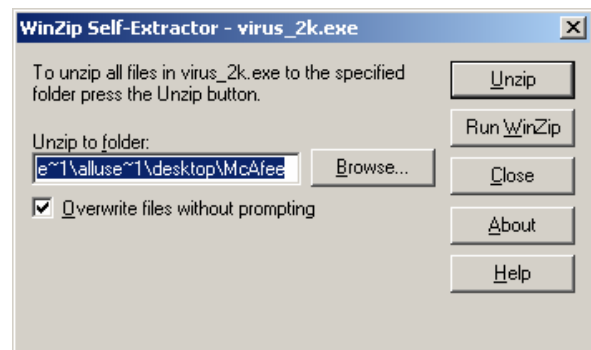


7. It might take anywhere from a few seconds to a few minutes for you to download this file.



If a window like the one above appears click **Open Folder** and you will be taken to the directory in which you saved the installation file.


8. Now you can double click on the installation files executable program file, **Virus\_2K.exe**, **98.exe**, or **NT.exe**.




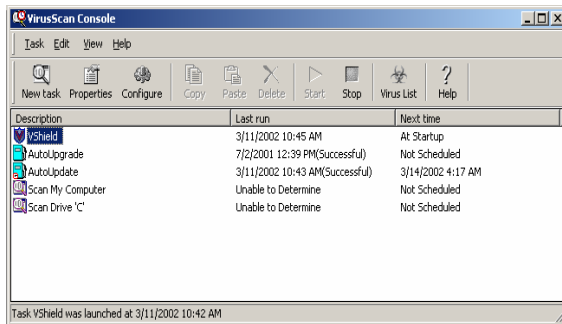
9. Click **Unzip**. Notice where it is unzipping to, by default it should go to the desktop in a folder named **McAfee**.
10. Go to the desktop and open this folder by double clicking on it. Find the **setup.exe** file and double click on it. This will begin the installation. The install wizard will ask you a few questions. You must agree to the License

Agreement to continue with the install. For most users the default setting should be fine, so click **Next** until the installation is finished.

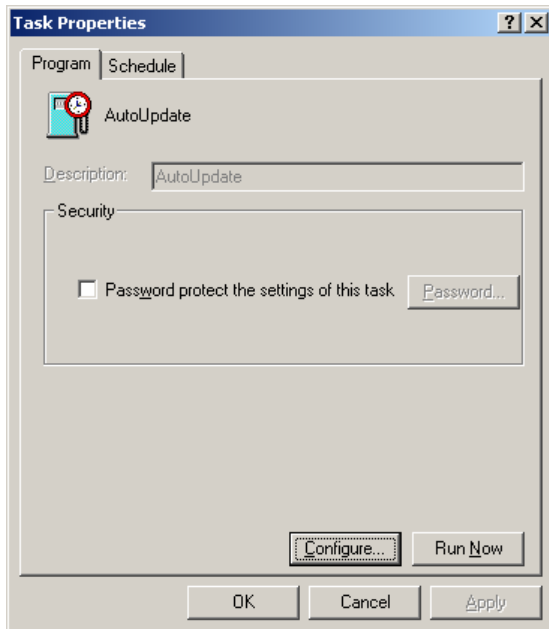
## Auto Update

1. Once Installed it will do a scan of your drive and check for any viruses. You should also notice 2 new icons in your task bar that look like this:  10:45 AM

2. Double click the  to bring up the McAfee Virus Scan Console:



To update your .DAT files double click **AutoUpdate** and click **Run Now**.




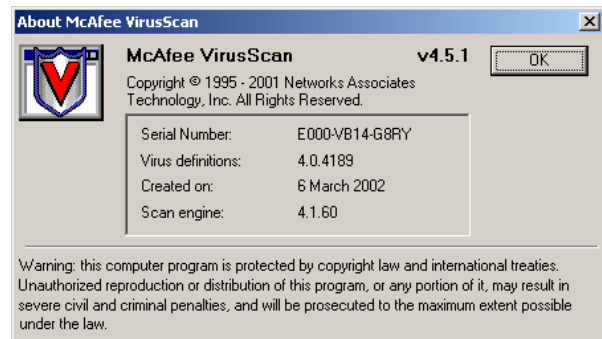
It will begin an AutoUpdate using the configured server at CNS.

3. Once updated you should see a screen like this:



Note: In some cases the newest .DAT files will already be installed. You may receive a dialog box indicating this.

4. To see what the date of the .DAT or virus definition files is, right click the  in the task bar and choose **About**. You should see something like this:



Notice the “**created on date**” to determine how new your files are.

5. The program is set to auto update at 4a.m. every Thursday. If your computer is not powered on at this time, it will update within one hour of being powered-on after this date and time.

Notes: There are many additional settings and changes that can be made to the scanning done by McAfee on your computer. Some of these settings can cause your computer to seem to slow down as the Virus scan program scans every file you download from the Internet or as an attachment through email. Make sure you know the level of security that you want to use.
