Recommended High School Preparation

Ohio University strongly recommends that all applicants complete a college-preparatory secondary school curriculum in the country of residence, presenting above average grades. For example:

- Equivalent of 2.8 GPA/4.0 scale
- IB curriculum guidelines: average of 5 across all subjects
- Cambridge curriculum guidelines: 6 passes of C or higher based on IGCSE (O-levels)

Some programs have higher admission standards than the general University guidelines. See ohio.edu/freshman-selective for details.

Application Process

Ohio University operates on a holistic, selective review. Any student for whom a visa is required to study in the U.S. should submit an international application. Ohio University is a member of The Common Application. The application opens annually in August at commonapp.org.

Ohio University offers an ACT/SAT test-optional pathway for admission. All applicants, including test-optional applicants, will be eligible to be considered for University benefits, including direct admission to academic programs, merit-based scholarships, and honors and scholars programs.

English Proficiency

To begin full-time academic study at OHIO, international applicants must show proof of English proficiency. Accepted tests, required scores and exemptions can be found at ohio.edu/admissions/international/apply.

Entering Semester Early Action Deadline* Rolling Admission Deadline

Fall (Late August).....November 15.....February 1
Spring (Mid-January).....November 1

*Applicants who meet the fall Early Action Deadline will receive priority consideration for direct entry to academic programs, merit scholarship programs, and University honors and scholars experiences. Merit scholarship awards are only available to international students who begin their studies in the fall semester. Transfer students should complete applications according to rolling admission deadlines.

Scholarships

Our generous academic merit-based scholarships represent our commitment to investing in international students. Merit scholarship awards are only available to international students who begin their studies in the fall semester. Apply by the November 15 Early Action Deadline for priority consideration. No additional application is required. SAT or ACT exams are not required for consideration, and awards are renewable for all four years.

Many colleges, schools and departments consider students admitted to their academic programs for additional scholarship opportunities.
