The scheduling scenario below is intended to present a sample pattern by which this major can be completed in three years. It assumes that the student has, before matriculating at OHIO, at least nine semester hours' worth of credit that apply toward University or College requirements (in this example, credit for ENG 1510, a Humanities course, and a Social Science course).

Students interested in the English – Pre-law degree should, however, understand that the skills and habits of thought that make the study of English both an excellent preparation for law school and personally rewarding develop through practice over time. For these reasons, your career goals may be best advanced through the traditional four-year period for college. Those interested in pursuing this shorter option need to work closely with an academic advisor to develop a specific plan.
