Global Studies - Europe

The scheduling scenario below is intended to present an example pattern by which this major can be completed in three years. Those interested in pursuing this option need to work with an academic advisor to develop a specific plan to earn the 120 credit hours required for graduation.

Global Studies – Europe students must be aware of the following requirements:

- Complete one advisor-approved education abroad or internship experience which complements area and language of study; and is at least 5 weeks in duration. Transfer credits may vary, so students need to consult with their academic advisor.
- In combination with your B.A. language requirement, complete a total of 3 years in one European language or equivalent.
