Health Services Administration Major

The Department of Social and Public Health intends to offer a three-year baccalaureate degree route to students pursuing a Health Services Administration major. This option will be open to students who complete 25 hours of academic credit spread over two summer terms or through advanced placement or concurrent enrollment credit completed while in high school. Other students will also be able to pursue this degree in a four-year time frame.

The scheduling scenario below is intended to present an example pattern by which this major can be completed in three years. Those interested in pursuing this option need to work with an academic advisor to develop a specific plan to earn the 121 credit hours required for graduation.
