The Online Bachelor of Human Services at Ohio University is designed for students who have completed an associate degree or 60 semester hours and wish to further their education. Students will demonstrate leadership, problem solving skills, and guidance by addressing societal needs through concentrations of social services and public health. Students will explore historical aspects, technology skill attainment, job requirements, models of service delivery, and skills in the helping process. Graduates are eligible for work performed in various settings including residential facilities and community agencies. Finally, graduates of the program who desire to enter graduate programs are prepared to enter programs such as Counseling, Social Work and Psychology.

Degree Requirements

To fulfill minimum graduation requirements for the Bachelors of Applied Human and Consumer Sciences in Human Services major, a student must have completed all Ohio University graduation requirements: general education, College, major, and residency. Students must complete minimum of 30 semester credit hours of Ohio University credit; **elective hours may be required**; minimum of 50% of the major course requirements at Ohio University; and total hours for graduation (120 semester hours) with a 2.0 gpa.
