## Art History Bachelor of Arts

The OGTP designation guarantees the transfer and applicability of credits, but does not guarantee admission to a program. Some bachelor-degree granting programs may be competitive, and students should check with individual institutions for their program admission requirements.

- <sup>1</sup> OHIO recommends OAH058: 2-D Foundations (ART 1220) or OAH059: 3-D Foundations (ART 1230) to satisfy major requirement. Coursework will be required at OHIO if not completed in the associate degree.
- <sup>2</sup> Students who complete the minimum requirements of the Ohio Transfer 36, as included within the above pathway, prior to enrollment in a degree-seeking program at Ohio University will receive transfer credit equivalent to fulfilling Ohio University's BRICKS general education requirements in Foundations (excluding the Advanced Writing component, which requires completion of TME 002 Second Writing), Pillars, and Arches.

#### **Advising Notes:**

- <sup>1</sup> Assumes the student has completed the first two semesters of the foreign language sequence prior to entering Ohio University.
- <sup>2</sup> Students must complete at least 9 hours each of humanities, social sciences, and 6 hours natural sciences coursework. Courses transferred in will be reviewed on a course-by-course basis and may apply toward these requirements.
- <sup>3</sup>To qualify for a bachelor's degree, a student must complete all Ohio University graduation requirements: BRICKS general education, college, major, and residency. Students must complete a minimum of 60 semester hours of A&S courses at the 2000-level or above, and must complete at least 33 hours of courses from the list of approved A&S distribution area courses including 9 semester hours each of Humanities, Social Sciences, and Natural Sciences. Courses transferred in as 2000-level or higher A&S courses will count toward the 60 semester hours. Ohio University requires a minimum of 120 credit hours to earn a bachelor's degree. The total number of hours to complete the bachelor's degree may vary depending on the individual course selections made during the associate degree program.
