### Ohio University Music Bachelor of Arts

Effective beginning Academic Year 2021-22 (Last revised May 23, 2023)

The following table outlines how transfer credits will be applied to the Bachelor of Arts in Music degree at Ohio University for students who completed an Associate of Arts degree via the Ohio Guaranteed Music Transfer Pathway. The OGTP designation guarantees the transfer and applicability of credits, but does not guarantee admission to a program. Some bachelor-degree granting programs may be competitive, and students should check with individual institutions for their program admission requirements.

<sup>1</sup> OHIO recommends students complete OHS041 Western/World History and OAH005 Survey of Art History I & II. Additional A&S Distribution Area coursework in Humanities will be required if not completed in the associate degree.

<sup>2</sup> Taught separately or in combination. An entire sequence MUST BE COMPLETED and passed for classes that are sequential in nature. If the entire sequence is not completed and passed, the transfer student will be required to take a proficiency test to determine placement in the sequence at the receiving university. Any proficiency level, as determined by examination, performance jury, or other means, that is required of native students will also be required of transfer students for acceptance into the program.

<sup>3</sup>An entire sequence MUST BE COMPLETED and passed for classes that are sequential in nature. If the entire sequence is not completed and passed, the transfer student will be required to take a proficiency test to determine placement in the sequence at the receiving university. Any proficiency level, as determined by examination, performance jury, or other means, that is required of native students will also be required of transfer students for acceptance into the program. <sup>4</sup>One 60 minute lesson per week per term. Applied level entry standards are the responsibility of the receiving institution.

<sup>5</sup>Number of credits/years of major ensemble performance remaining at the receiving institution will be determined by the receiving institution based on the performance skill as demonstrated by the performance entry standard.

<sup>6</sup> Students who complete the minimum requirements of the Ohio Transfer 36, as included within the above pathway, prior to enrollment in a degree-seeking program at Ohio University will receive transfer credit equivalent to fulfilling Ohio University's BRICKS general education requirements in Foundations (excluding the Advanced Writing component, which requires completion of TME 002 Second Writing), Pillars, and Arches.

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The following additional coursework will be required to complete the Bachelor of Arts in Music degree at Ohio University after a student has completed their Associate of Arts Ohio Guaranteed Music Transfer Pathway degree. Some bachelor-degree granting programs may be competitive and admission into the program is not guaranteed. Students should check with individual institutions for their program admission requirements.

Advising Notes:

<sup>1</sup> To qualify for a bachelor's degree, a student must complete all Ohio University graduation requirements: BRICKS general education, college, major, and residency. Students must complete a minimum of 60 semester hours of A&S courses at the 2000-level or above, and must complete at least 33 hours of courses from the list of approved A&S distribution area courses including 9 semester hours each of Humanities, Social Sciences, and Natural Sciences. Courses transferred in as 2000-level or higher A&S courses will count toward the 60 semester hours. Ohio University requires a minimum of 120 credit hours to earn a bachelor's degree. The total number of hours to complete the bachelor's degree may vary depending on the individual course selections made during the associate degree program.
