Minor/Certificate Program: Students must complete a minor or certificate program (15 – 24 hours) to complete requirements of the major. The minor or certificate should be chosen in consultation with the student’s academic advisor. Students may not select the Recreation Management minor to fulfill this requirement.

Outdoor Recreation and Education General Requirements: To complete this major, students must fulfill the following requirements:

1. Maintain an accumulative grade point average (GPA) of C (2.0) or better in all courses taken at the University, and
2. Complete all courses in the Required Recreation Core and all required courses in the Outdoor Recreation and Education major with a grade of C (2.0) or better.
