Undergraduate Admissions Processes and Selective Requirements: University of Bayreuth students who are interested in pursuing the dual degree pathway must apply as a degree-seeking student to Ohio University's College of Business Sports Management program. Applications are subject to established deadline dates and current admission policies. Student's pursuing the dual degree pathway must have an accumulative 2.75 GPA or better and have completed the equivalent of ECON 1030 or ECON 1040 to be considered for admission. Requirements for ENG 1510/1610 equivalent will be completed at OHIO. Please refer to the Undergraduate Admissions' website (<https://www.ohio.edu/admissions/international>) for application deadlines. Students must earn an equivalent of a C- or better in order to receive transfer coursework.

Transferring University of Bayreuth Credit: In order to receive double degree credit at Ohio University, students must complete the outlined coursework and earn the equivalent of a C- or better in all University of Bayreuth courses. An official University of Bayreuth transcript should be requested after grades have been recorded for Year 1 and Year 3. Transcripts should be sent to the following address:

MATH 1350: Students are required to complete MATH 1350: Survey of Calculus or its equivalent. Students that must complete MATH 1350 while at OHIO are required to meet the following requisites: MATH 1321 or (C or better in 1200) or math placement level 2 or higher. Students that have not satisfied the requisites prior to enrollment at OHIO may be required to complete additional coursework and delay graduation.

Cultural Perspectives Requirement: The Cultural Perspectives requirement will be waived for international students on a F1 visa.

Internship Requirement: Students participating in the Dual Degree program will satisfy OHIO's SASM 3910 Internship requirement with the completion of University of Bayreuth's Bachelor Thesis. Students may also elect to complete a more traditional internship component during their fourth year at OHIO. Students interested in completing the OHIO Internship should meet with International Student and Faculty Services (ISFS) during Year 2 to discuss possible work authorization processes.

Specialization Requirement: The OHIO BSM degree requires students to complete a specialization component. Students participating in the double degree program may satisfy this component through coursework completed as part of the B.Sc. in Sports, Business and Law through the University of Bayreuth (UBT Sport Science Specialization or UBT Business Specialization). Students should work with their OHIO advisor for appropriate specialization selection. Students who are interested in completing an additional area of specialization, minor, or certificate should discuss options and additional coursework with their OHIO advisor.

Full-Time Status: Students should enroll in at least 12 semester hours each term to ensure a full-time status. Students should discuss options for additional coursework with their OHIO advisor.



Ohio University Degree Completion: This information is based off of the catalog requirements posted in 2023-2024 Ohio University and related University of Bayreuth equivalents. All information is subject to change without notice. Students must complete a minimum of 120 total semester hours and are responsible for tracking their degree completion.
