The possibility of successfully completing a three-year degree in the School of Visual Communication (VisCom) is difficult, but not impossible. The options will need to be individually defined for each major sequence track for them to be successful. This would also require the school to offer a junior level class in each sequence on-line or during the summer.

All Sequences in VisCom are currently designed as a series of required courses taking seven semesters to accomplish with one semester that does not have any required sequential VisCom class. This semester is in the third year of each sequence within the program.

The scheduling scenario below is intended to present an example pattern by which this major can be completed in three years. Those interested in pursuing this option need to work with an academic advisor to develop a specific plan to earn the 120 credit hours required for graduation.
