



THE PHILIP BEBB MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP For Study in Italy

These scholarships are intended to support research and study in Italy, including Italian language studies. Students in most cases must be enrolled in a study abroad program. Applications are accepted twice yearly in the fall and spring semesters.

Fall applications are appropriate for participation in programs the following spring semester, including spring break study abroad. Spring applications are appropriate for participation in programs the following summer.

Eligibility Criteria

- Undergraduate History or History Pre-Law Major enrolled full-time at Ohio University
- Cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0
- Enrolled or accepted with full intention to enroll in a study abroad program in Italy

Your application should include the following documents:

- Completed application form and personal statement
- Current DARS report
- One letter of reference (preferably from a professor in the Department of History)
- Documentation of your enrollment in a study abroad program in Italy (or your acceptance in with intention to enroll). This documentation could be from the program itself, or from the Office of Global Opportunities.

Scholarship applications should be submitted to the history department's director of undergraduate studies by the announced deadline for that cycle. Spring and Fall semester deadlines are announced via email.
