Research Interests

Decision under uncertainty; Aspects of formation processing, such as evaluation, elimination, simplification, and information search stopping rule; Judgment Biases and the cognitive processes involved in that; namely, perception, attention, memory, experience, etc...

Theories:

Decision Theory - There are 3 main branches of Decision theory, normative, descriptive, and prescriptive. My research focus on both descriptive (how people make decisions), and prescriptive (how decision should be made considering human's faulty cognitive systems). Decision theory also involves the examination of probability bias assessment, regret aversion, expected utility, and risk.

Decision Analysis: Decisions analysis models follow the 3 decision theory branches.

Descriptive models focus on how people make decisions in their everyday live;

Normative models focus on how perfectly rational agents should make decisions; and

Prescriptive models focus on how people should made decisions in practice, considering

that they may not always be perfectly rational agents. As aforementioned, my research focus on descriptive and prescriptive models, Moreover, my research also involves process tracing models.
