Students should work out a course of study tailored to their individual needs and academic interests in conjunction with their faculty advisor.

¹ EDCP 544 courses are 2-hour explorations of important skills/areas/topics within student affairs. Two of these courses are required, however students often take more (counted as "elective" hours). Two options are typically offered each quarter and by planning to take these courses in the fall, winter, and spring quarters, a student will have the full selection of availability over the two years. However, they can be taken at any time and more than one 544 course may be taken in a quarter Please note that some EDCP 743 courses can also be used to fulfill this requirement.

² EDHE 588 must be completed prior to taking EDHE 786

³ Higher Education Requirements include a choice of TWO from the following: EDHE 687, 688, 689, 778, 779, 785. [EDHE 588 should be taken *before* 2nd EDHE required course]

⁴ EDHE 691 should be taken <u>in the 2nd year</u>; winter quarter is most common but fall or spring is possible. If the thesis option is chosen instead of writing a seminar paper, this course is not necessary. Thesis hours should be spread across the quarters of the 2nd year.
