The supplemental tables compiled in this document update data that were originally presented in *Instructional Faculty and Staff in Public 2-year Colleges* by James Palmer (May 2000). Palmer's report analyzed data from the 1993 National Study of Postsecondary Faculty (NSOPF:93) to examine differences between subgroups of faculty and staff within public 2-year colleges. The following supplemental tables reproduce many tables from the original report. NOTE: In many cases the numbers generated in these tables differ slightly from the originals. These variations are due in part to the existence of multiple recoded versions of the institution type variable, as well as to updates in weighting formulas since 2000. The institution-type variable used in these tables most closely approximates the original Palmer tables while remaining compatible with the NSOPF:99 and NSOP:04 data tables in this series, and spot checks of individual tables did not find discrepancies with the overall patterns visible in the original Palmer tables.
