Besides these italicized courses, there is an option to take other courses if you want to develop a specialization or area of concentration, but this will require more than the minimum of 30 credit hours. Consult with your advisor.*

*\*It is fine to take just one course a semester. However, if you are applying for federal loans, you must be registered for at least 5 credit hours per semester. You can request and take two credit hours of independent study to reach the needed 5 hours. It would be better to add a course each fall and spring and develop a specialization or concentration or could be used for the +30 beyond a Master's degree in some States for their salary scales. Consult with your HR officers. Again, this will result in going beyond 30 hours required for this degree.*
