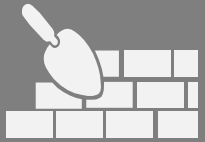

Terms

Double-Dipping

- When one course satisfies two requirements in a student's degree program using the same credit hours

Combination

- When one course satisfies two requirements by adding credit hours requirements of different requirements into a single course

Add-On

- When two distinct (yet related) required or optional courses are offered concurrently

Sequence

- When one course is a requisite for another course consecutively

Foundations Combinations

Foundation courses may be **combined** with select BRICKS components if the course achieves all learning outcomes and content expectations for both BRICKS components.

Foundation course...	may be combined with...	Min Total Hrs.
Written Communication (3) +	Any Bridge (1)	= 4
Intercultural Explorations (2) +	Any Bridge (except Diversity & Practice) (1)	= 3
	Advanced Writing (3)	= 5
Quantitative Reasoning (3) +	Any Bridge (1)	= 4
Advanced Writing (3) +	Any Bridge (1)	= 4
	Intercultural Explorations (2)	= 5
	Capstone (2)	= 5

NOT PERMITTED

Written Communication ≠ Pillar

Quantitative Reasoning ≠ Pillar

Advanced Writing ≠ Pillar

Written Communication ≠ Arch

Quantitative Reasoning ≠ Arch

Advanced Writing ≠ Arch

Double-Dipping Intercultural Explorations

Intercultural Exploration courses may be **double-dipped** with any Pillars or Arch course if the course achieves all learning outcomes and content expectations for both components.

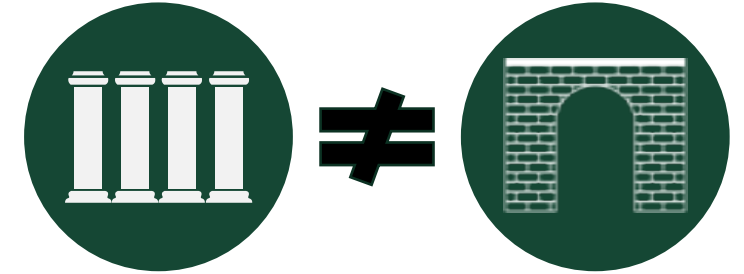
Intercultural Explorations ≠ Diversity & Practice

Pillars and Arches Combinations

Pillar or Arch courses may be combined with a Bridge course or may add-on a required or optional Bridge course.



Course...	may be combined with...	Min Total Hrs.
Any Pillar (3) +	Any Bridge (1)	= 4
Any Arch (3) +	Any Bridge (1)	= 4



NOT PERMITTED

- Pillar courses cannot be combined or double-counted with Arch courses (or vice versa).

Bridges Options

All Bridge courses require at least one credit hour of formalized instruction and out-of-class assignments (*i.e.*, 3-4 weeks of a 14-week course) focused on teaching and learning the specified common goal learning outcomes. Accordingly, course options fulfilling Bridge components may be:



1

Stand-Alone

- 1+ credit hour course focused on common goal teaching & learning, enrolled independent of other courses

2

Add-On

- 1 credit hour course focused on common goal teaching & learning, enrolled concurrently (optional or required) with another course

3

Embedded

- 3+ credit hour course where 1 credit hour is focused on common goal teaching & learning

4

Sequenced

- Sequence of courses where required sequence delivers 1 credit hour of common goal teaching & learning across the sequence

Double-Dipping Learning & Doing



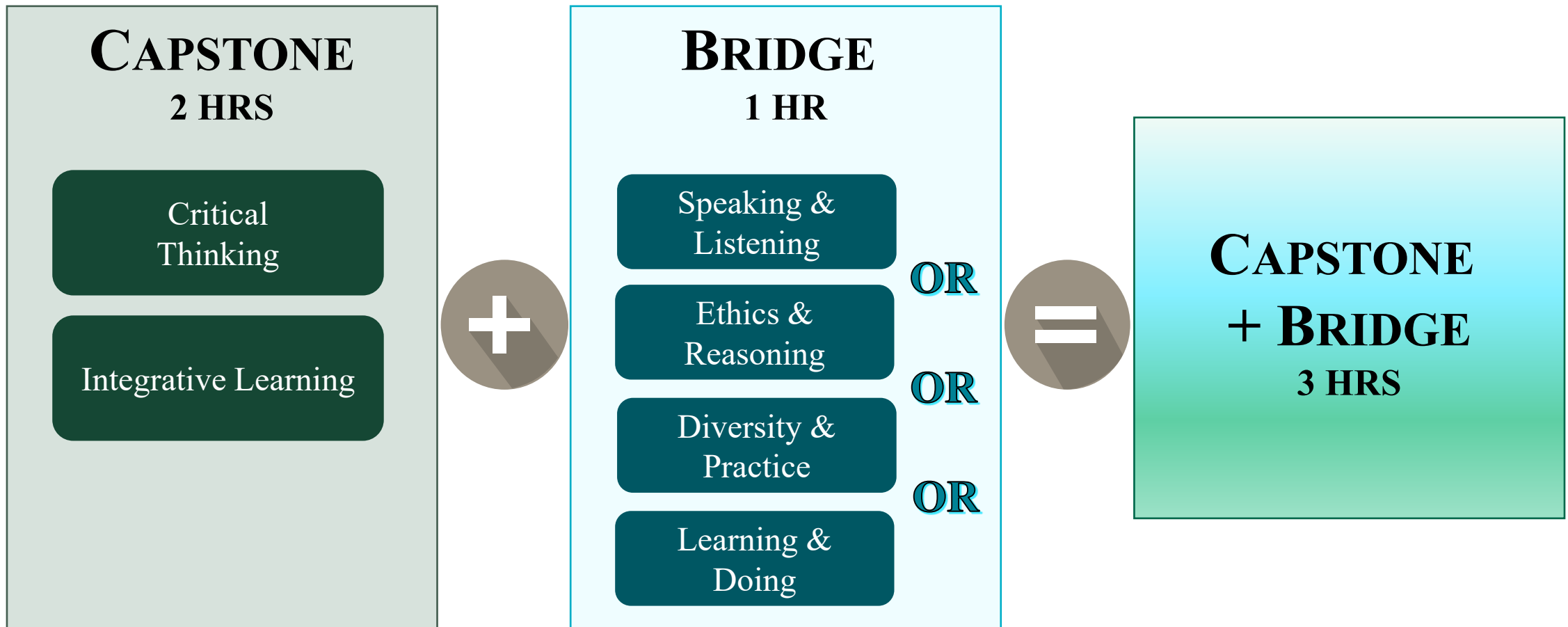
Learning & Doing courses may be **double-dipped** with any Pillars or Arch course if the course achieves all learning outcomes and content expectations for both components.

Bridge course...	may be double-dipped with...	Min Total Hrs.
Learning & Doing (1) +	Humanities: Texts and Contexts (3)	= 3
	Humanities: Arts (3)	= 3
	Natural Sciences (3)	= 3
	Social and Behavioral Sciences (3)	= 3
	Constructed World (3)	= 3
	Connected World (3)	= 3
	Natural World (3)	= 3

Capstone Combinations

All Capstone courses require at least two credit hours. Accordingly, a Capstone course may be combined with a Bridge component if the course achieves all learning outcomes and content expectations for both components. When combined, a single three-hour course can achieve both BRICKS components.

Double-Dipping *outside* BRICKS

Certificate

No restrictions on double-counting BRICKS courses for college, major, minor, or certificate requirements or electives.

Summary

Some foundation courses can be combined with other courses.

Intercultural Explorations may be double-dipped with Pillar or Arch courses

Courses may be Pillars or Arches – but not both.

Bridges can be combined with other BRICKS components in a variety of ways.

Capstones may be combined with Bridges.

BRICKS courses may double-dip college, major, minor, and/or certificate requirements or electives.
