

Music Leadership Certificate

Completion Requirements

The Certificate requires 12 credit hours total.

All students must complete the following required course:

- MUS 5671: Music Administration (3)
This course examines issues associated with the administration of music programs both at the university level and in the private sector. Students will explore how to effectively manage music programs including symphony orchestras, professional and amateur performing ensembles, as well as music schools and departments.

Students choose a minimum of 7 credit hours from the following:

- Applied lessons (2)
- Ensembles (2)
- Music History elective (3)
- Music Theory elective (3)
- MUS 5860 Teaching Music in Higher Education (1)

Students choose 1 course from Music Literature (2)

- MUS 5210: Literature of Choral Music
- MUS 5212: Literature of Chamber Music
- MUS 5213: Literature of Orchestra Music
- MUS 5214: Literature of Organ Music
- MUS 5215: Literature of Opera
- MUS 5216: Literature of Band Music

Admission Requirements

- Interview with a School of Music administrator
- Bachelor's degree in music or equivalent professional experience is required
