

SPRING 2021 PL 1090 PERFORMANCE LAB PERFORMANCE REQUEST PROCEDURE

Due to the pandemic, there will be no live student performance PL's in spring 2021.

Students wishing to receive PL performance credit in spring 2021 will need to make an audio or video recording, upload it to one of the designated platforms (*see below*) and submit the appropriate online form by the designated deadline (see links below)

Upon receipt of the form, Dr. Rischin will contact you and your applied instructor for approval. A program will then be made, posted on Blackboard and the PL bulletin board, and emailed to you, the other musicians, and your applied instructor.

Performances will be viewed/listened to on

Wednesday, April 7 and Wednesday, April 21 from 12:55-1:50pm.

Performances must be limited to 10 minutes or less and priority will be given to students seeking PL performance credit for their major. However, if time permits, longer submissions and additional applications will be considered.

STEPS TO FOLLOW

- Discuss your recording plans with the applied professor supervising your performance.
- Make a high quality audio or video recording after consulting with him/her. Be sure to present yourself professionally, with appropriate dress and surroundings (if making a video). Please announce your name, repertoire, and any collaborating musicians in the performance.
- Upload the recording to Youtube (video) or GoogleDrive (audio) so you have a shareable link.
- Fill out and submit the appropriate online form below. Be sure to read the instructions on the form and answer **ALL** the questions that apply to you. Please skip any questions that do not apply to you.
