The **Junior Portfolio Review** is for students who wish to continue in graphic design courses at the 4000 level.

You will make a **verbal presentation** to the graphic design faculty in 5 minutes or less.

During this review with the graphic design faculty you will present

- your strengths and progress over the past year
- provide your vision of the senior year including ideas for your degree project and reflect upon the areas of design which interests you.

Bring your **portfolio** so that you can show and explain the work you have done in the junior graphic design studios.

Please fill out and bring the **form** provided on the following page along with you. This should be typed and can be designed as you feel appropriate.

Rehearse. Time yourself. Be prepared. By limiting your initial presentation to 5 minutes, you will allow the faculty to engage in a 10-minute discussion with you regarding your performance over the year. The faculty will make suggestions for you to consider for the summer and identify areas needing improvement. These reviews will occur on **March 13. There will be no graphic design classes on these days.** A sign-up sheet will be posted closer to these dates.

Eligibility for juniors to enter 4000-level graphic design classes is based on a portfolio review of the work completed in ART 3510 and 3520. Please remember you must have 16 credit hours at 3000/4000 level studio electives in order to graduate with a BFA.
