7. CITI Program offers two kinds of documentation to reflect course completion: Completion Reports and Completion Certificates. Ohio University requires that you retain a copy of the **Completion Report** with your records. You do not need to upload the completion report into the LEO system. You can access your Completion Report from the Records tab. See below.
