4. Now it's your turn! Think about how you can carry on your activist's legacy through your social media. Will you create something? Share information? Go to a march? Write your ideas in the space below!

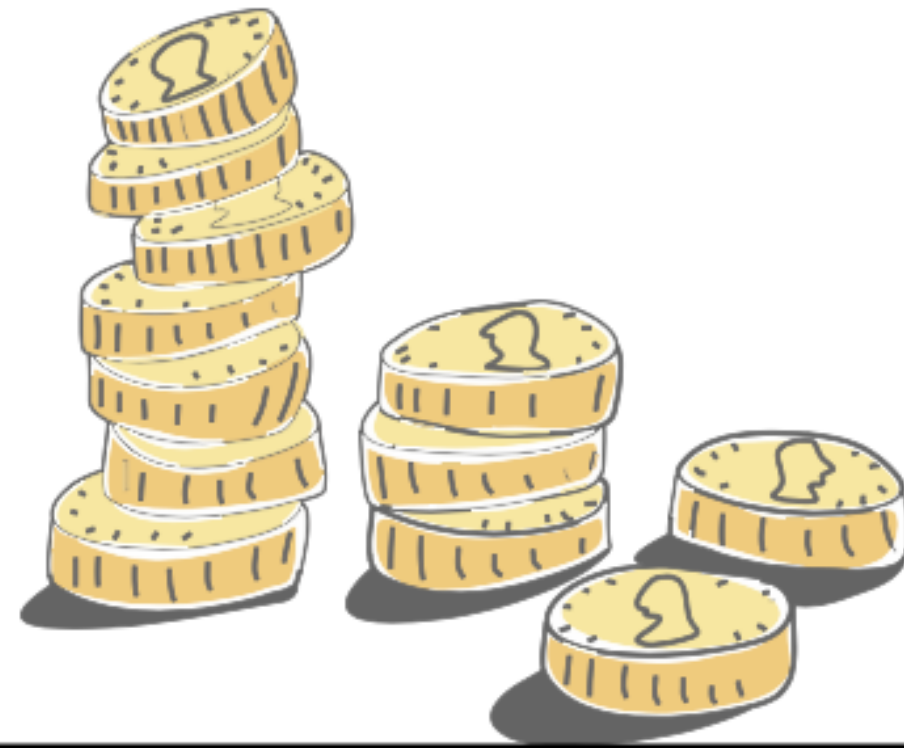
