### Allowable Courses

#### Level 1

In most cases, students who have completed fewer than 15 semester hours may only enroll in courses that fall within the Ohio Transfer 36, Transfer Assurance Guides (TAG) and Career-Technical Assurance Guides (CTAG) or any course in computer science, information technology, anatomy physiology and foreign language (including American Sign Language). All courses in the following computer science, information technology and foreign language subject areas are eligible level 1 courses:

Foreign Language Subject Areas: ARAB, AKAN, CHIN, CSD (language classes only), DSI, FR, GER, GK, HIND, INDO, ITAL, JPN, LAT, MALA, RUS, SUDN, SPAN, SWAH, THAI and WOL Computer Science and Information Technology Subject Areas: CS, CTCH, ITS and MIS

#### Study Skills and Career Guidance Courses

Courses that are designed to assist students with study skills or academic / career success are considered eligible level 1 courses. Examples of these would be EDCE 2010 and UC 1100. Please consult with the Assistant Director of Dual Enrollment Programs if there are other similar courses you would like considered.

#### Level 2 Exceptions

Students may take Level 2 courses prior to completing 15 semester hours if one of the following applies:

- The Level 2 course has a Level 1 course requisite the student has successfully completed.
- The student has successfully completed a Level 1 course in the same, specific subject area.
- A student tests directly into a Level 2 course.

#### Level 2

Students who have completed 15 or more semester hours can enroll in any course for which requisites have been met and which has not been designated as “non-allowable” by the Ohio Department of Higher Education (see below for a list of non-allowable courses).

### Course Restrictions / Non-Allowable Courses

Based on State law, the following type of courses are not eligible for College Credit Plus students:

- One-on-one private instruction course
- Course with fees that are equal to or greater than \$750.00
- Study abroad courses
- Physical education courses
- P/F or S/U grades (unless the course is an internship or is a transferable course for all students enrolled)
- Remedial course
- Sectarian religion course
- Courses that require an overnight experience

## Course Selection and Availability

Admission to CC+ does not guarantee admission to specific courses. In accordance with the Ohio Revised Code, Ohio University must take care to give registration priority to its degree-seeking students while attempting to provide CC+ students with reasonable class choices. However, once a CC+ student has officially registered for a course they will not be displaced.

Not all level 1 courses listed are guaranteed to be offered on all of Ohio University's campuses or available online every semester. Please plan ahead by working with your academic advisor to create a schedule based on available course offerings. Participants in the CC+ program are encouraged to work closely with their college advisor and high school counselors to assure that they are taking the proper courses, including those necessary for high school graduation credit.
