## SAFETY REQUIREMENTS FOR RECREATIONAL or CEREMONIAL FIRES

Complete, comply with this checklist, and submit to the Fire Protection Coordinator,

Environmental Health & Safety, 175 University Service Center at least 5 days before the proposed event.

The only Approved location for a recreational fire is the "Morton Field." Any other sites or exceptions on university property must be approved by the Facilities Grounds Department. This form does not include any fees, charges or fines associated with hosting a recreational or ceremonial fire. Athens Fire Department may refuse permission or put out any fire it deems dangerous or refuse permission depending on weather conditions.
