INSTRUCTIONS

1. Competent Person must complete and submit form to Safety for review. Upon approval, Permit and area must be posted.
2. Fire Watch: Prior to leaving area, do final Inspection and complete Daily Fire Watch Log.
3. Any changes in usage or configuration will void the permit and require a new submittal. Competent person must resubmit prior to expiration date indicated on the permit.

REQUIRED PRECAUTIONS CHECKLIST

- Available sprinklers, hose streams and extinguishers are in service.
- Hot Work equipment in good repair.

WITHIN 35 FEET OF WORK

- Flammable liquids, dust, lint and oily deposits removed.
- Explosive atmosphere in area eliminated.
- Floors swept clean of combustibles.
- Combustible floors wet down, covered with damp sand, metal or fire-resistant tarpaulins.
- Remove other combustibles or protect with fire-resistant tarpaulins or metal shields.
- All wall and floor openings covered.
- Fire-resistant tarpaulins suspended beneath work to collect sparks.

WORK ON WALLS OR CEILINGS

- Construction noncombustible and without combustible covering.
- Combustibles moved away from other side of walls.

WORK ON ENCLOSED EQUIPMENT

- Equipment cleaned of all combustibles.
- Containers purged of flammable vapors.

FIRE WATCH

- Fire watch to be provided during and for 60 minutes after work.
- Fire watch to be provided for 4 hours after work in areas without smoke detection.
- Supplied with suitable extinguishers.
- Trained in the use of equipment and in sounding fire alarm.
- Fire watch may be required for adjoining areas above and below.
