INFORMATION FOR ALL STUDENTS

- Non program-related entertainment, souvenirs, and additional travel are not included in the travel cost estimate and should be budgeted separately.
- Additional fees: Semester fees will be billed to students' accounts as normal. If you are eligible to waive fees such as the health insurance, student legal, and wellbeing fees, you may log into your "My OHIO Portal" to complete the process.
- NOTE to all Denmark Exchange applicants: 1) Prior to departure, students apply for a Danish Residence Permit. This requires a trip to a visa processing center, typically in Chicago. Among other documentation, applicants must show the evidence of having \$1,000 per month they will spend in Denmark in a personal bank account in the student's name. For the spring semester, this equals \$5,000. 2) For accommodations (housing), students will be paying first month's rent and a security deposit prior to departure from the U.S. The total amount of these charges is estimated at \$2,500. Please discuss these requirements with your OGO advisor.

- COVID-19 Travel Information: Participants should have access to contingency funds and resources to cover unanticipated medical or other expenses.
