

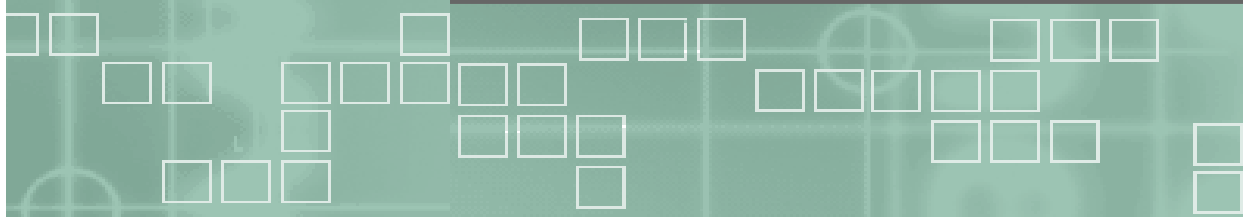

Executive Summary

Students

- 21,182 students enrolled at the Athens campus (22,647 including Lifelong & Distance Learning), 9,712 students enrolled at regional campuses for a total enrollment of 32,359, Fall 2009
- 83% of the students enrolled at the Athens campus are Ohio residents, with the greatest number of students coming from Cuyahoga county
- 5,693 total degrees awarded from the university in 2008-2009
- 14,204 new first-year students applied for admission in Fall 2009, with 11,591 admitted and 4,072 students who enrolled at the university
- 3,776 new graduate students applied in Fall 2009, with 1,772 admitted and 976 students who enrolled
- The first-year student retention rate for the Athens campus is 82%
- 69% of undergraduates enrolled at the Athens campus graduate within 6 years (the 3rd highest graduation rate in the state of Ohio), with an additional 24% of students who transferred to another institution
- Recreation & Sport Sciences is the undergraduate major with the largest number of students enrolled, and Curriculum & Instruction is the graduate major with the largest number of students enrolled
- 281 undergraduate majors from which to choose
- The mean ACT score of first-year undergraduate students is 24, which is higher than both the national and state averages; 16% of the first-year undergraduate students ranked in the top 10% of their high school class

- 1,126 full-time faculty, 790 part-time faculty and 4,780 total employees
- 22:1 student to faculty ratio at the Athens campus in Fall 2009

OHIO UNIVERSITY: A Brief History

Ohio University was chartered by the state of Ohio in 1804 and is the oldest university in the Northwest Territory. Located in the scenic Appalachian foothills of southeastern Ohio, its classic residential campus is one of the most attractive in the nation. The charm of tree-lined brick walkways on the university's College Green makes you feel as if you are at a small college rather than a large university. One can walk between most campus buildings within about 10 minutes.

It is possible to live a mile away from the university buildings in a residential neighborhood and walk to work, or to live on a farm within a 20 minute drive. The city of Athens is surrounded by a patchwork of hardwood forests that constitute the Wayne National Forest.

Under the new 2005 Carnegie Foundation for the Advancement of Teaching classifications, Ohio University is designated a Research University (high research activity) under the Basic Classification category. Only 103 schools – 2.3 percent – of the 4,391 schools assessed by the Carnegie Foundation are classified as a research university (high research activity). Ohio University's institutional peers are all classified as either a research university (very high research activity) or a research university (high research activity).

Ohio University's roots are in post-Revolutionary War America. In 1786 a group of veterans petitioned Congress to purchase, through the Ohio Company of Associates, one-and-a-half million acres north and west of the Ohio River.

Revenue from two townships in the Ohio Company purchase was set aside for support of a university. In 1808 the university opened with three students, and in 1815 awarded its first two bachelor's degrees.

The university graduated a total of only 145 students until after the Civil War. By 1920 it had 1,072 students, but it was not until after World War II that the university began to approach its present size.

In the 1950s the student population grew from 4,600 to 8,000, and the 1960s saw enrollment burgeon from about 10,000 to some 18,000 students on the Athens campus. In the early 1970s, during the Vietnam era, the student population fell below 13,000. Today the Athens campus serves about 21,000 students.

Since 1946 the university's service as the major educational and cultural institution in southeastern Ohio has included regional campuses in Chillicothe, Ironton, Lancaster, St. Clairsville, and Zanesville. Today, the regional campuses collectively enroll over 9,000 students, making the full-time, part-time, and continuing education enrollment for Ohio University over 32,000.

University actual expenditures total \$563 million for all of its operations on all of its campuses. Ohio University is the largest employer in Athens County, with an annual payroll exceeding \$365 million.

Student Data Definitions:

Admission statistics - Number of students who applied for admission, were admitted, and enrolled each fall quarter

Degrees awarded - Number of students receiving degrees awarded in each year. Students earning multiple degrees in one year are counted according to the number of degrees earned. Students with more than one major are counted only once.

Graduation rates - Number and percent of students in cohort who graduated. Students are counted in each major according to the last major in which they enrolled (or graduated) because of the possibility that students can change majors many times over the course of 4, 5, or 6 years. Each cohort consists of first-time, full-time, degree-seeking freshmen.

New First-Year student - New freshman as defined by the Office of Admissions

State and County of Residence - Students' home address at the time of their application for admission

Student FTE - Number of credit hours taken by students divided by 15

Student headcount - Number of students enrolled for credit in a given quarter. Campus, college, and major are attributed to the student from data in the Student Information System. Students may be counted more than once if they are enrolled at more than one campus, but within each campus students with more than one college or major are counted only once.

Student retention - Percent of students entering each fall quarter as degree-seeking first-year students who return as second-year students. Students are counted in each major according to the last major in which they enrolled because of the possibility that students can change majors after first enrolling. Each cohort consists of first-time, full-time, degree-seeking freshmen.

Transfer-out rates - Number and percent of students in a freshman cohort who did not graduate from Ohio University, but subsequently enrolled at another college or university.

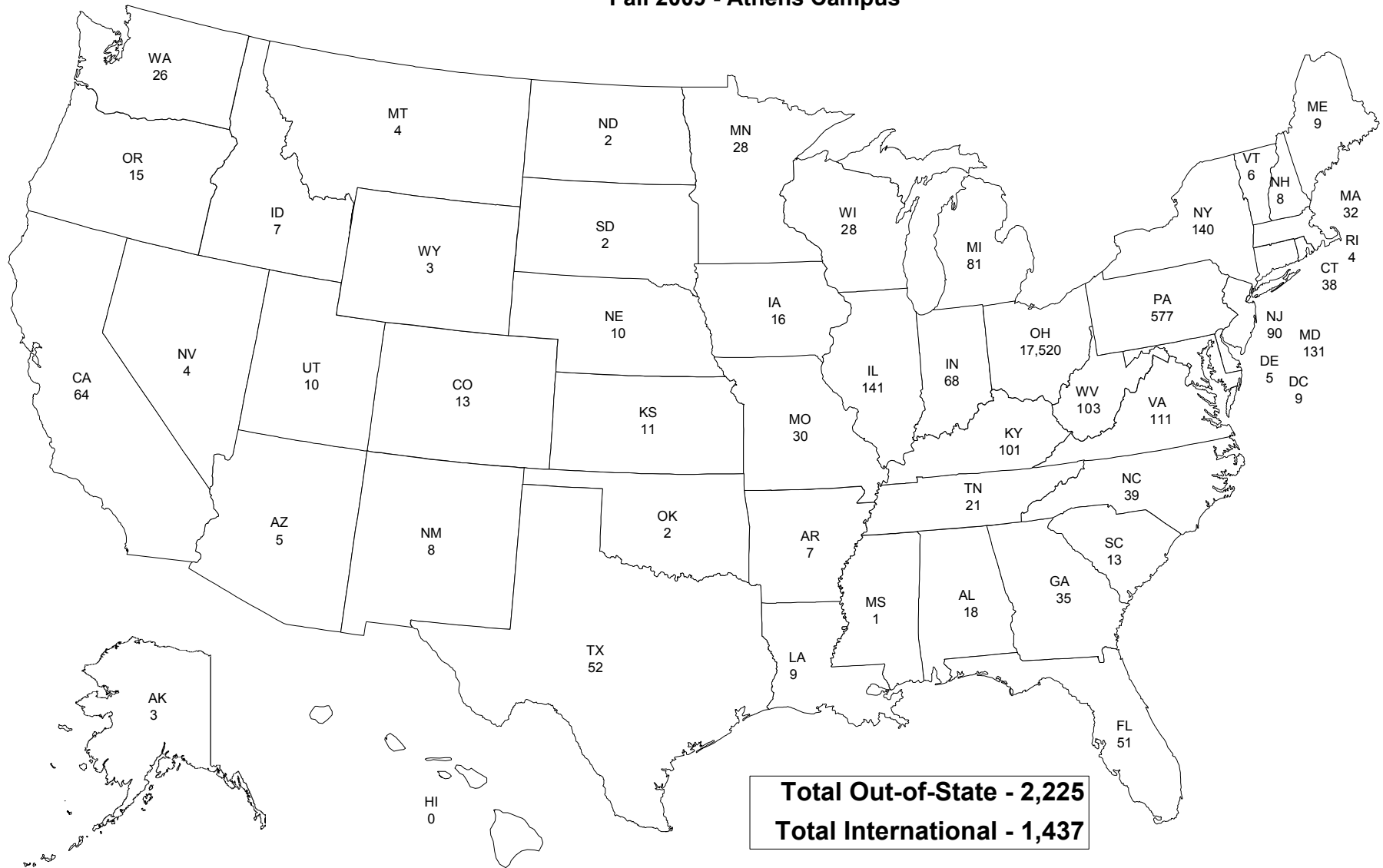
