

# Relocate Day Information Sheet

*Relocate Day is a program designed to assist Regional Campus Ohio University students in their transition to the Athens Campus; it is free for students. Family and guests are welcome to join students, and there will be a parallel program offered for them in the afternoon; there is a \$20.00 fee per person. Please plan to attend the entire program the term before you intend to move to Athens. In an effort to make sure your first term in Athens is very successful, you will be the first students to register for classes in Athens.*

If you choose to park in lots 51 – 54 or in the South Green Garage, please place the pass on your dashboard before you leave your car. There is a transit stop available in Lots 53/54 which is serviced by the Purple CATS Loop. This is an express loop which runs every 10 minutes Monday-Friday 7 AM – 5:30 PM and drops off at the 4<sup>th</sup> floor of Baker University Center. Individuals also have the ability to track the free shuttles in real time via the Double Map app which can be downloaded to smart phones or viewed on the web at: <https://apcats.doublemap.com/map/>

If you prefer to park closer to our sessions in a lot that costs \$.75 per hour, you can park in the above ground lot adjacent to Baker University Center. The Baker University Center Garage is also an option for \$1.00 per hour.

## **Relocate Day Schedule – Please plan to attend the entire day.**

Course registration will take place with the assistance of an academic advisor in the afternoon of Relocate Day. However, in order to be able to register in the afternoon, students are required to attend the entire Relocate Day program, beginning with check-in before 10:00 am. The entire Relocate Day program is complementary for students, including lunch; there is a \$40.00 fee per person for family and guests. You will also take a campus tour, where you will learn your way around, see more of campus, and get to know other students in your college.

## **Changing Majors – Possible for some majors on Relocate Day**

If you are not currently in the college that you would like to be in (for example, you are in University College and you would like to be in the College of Arts and Sciences) you will be able to change your major on Relocate Day. This is ONLY for majors that are open to all students who have at least a 2.0 accumulative GPA. For example, you are able to change to majors in the College of Arts and Sciences and some majors in the College of Health Sciences and Professions. This is NOT possible for students interested in the Scripps College of Communication. These majors require an additional application, as do majors in the Patton College of Education and the College of Fine Arts. Please investigate these selective majors on-line before Relocate Day if you intend to pursue them.

## **Course Registration – Please bring a laptop computer or tablet.**

Please read about the major you are hoping to complete in the undergraduate catalog before Relocate Day so you have an idea of the courses you might take. Also, if you own or can borrow a laptop computer, it would be helpful for you to bring it with you, so you may reference the catalog, look on-line to see what courses are available, and register for courses.
